Due to our current restrictions, we are unable to hold our traditional Fall Fair this year at St. Thomas'. However, our Fall Fair Committee has planned two activities which you may be interested in supporting.

1. Pantry Sale

Phone orders will be taken for Pantry items from **Sept 18 to Oct 5**. These orders will be available for pick-up at the Church on **Saturday, Oct 24**. Quantities may be limited, so order early; it's 'first come - first served'.

- Jams: Strawberry, Raspberry, Black Currant, Gooseberry, Partridgeberry, Blueberry, Raspberry/Gooseberry, Rhubarb/Orange, Apricot (no sugar), and Orange Marmalade. One cup or ½ -cup sizes. (\$2.50 to \$4)
- Pickled Beets, Mustard Pickles, Bread & Butter Pickles, Partridgeberry Pickles, Gooseberry Pickles, Rhubarb Pickles and Whole-berry Cranberry Sauce. Various sizes. (\$2.50 to \$5.)
- Home Made Bread: White; Whole Wheat; Multigrain; and Raisin. (\$4 to \$4.50)
- Cakes: Dark Fruit; Boiled Fruit; Cherry; Cream Cheese Apricot; Gumdrops; Chocolate Boiled Cake; and Diabetic Fruit Cake. (\$25 each)
- 12-piece trays of either Chocolate Fudge or Assorted Fudge. (\$5)
